Outside of the United Kingdom, Afternoon Tea/Cream Tea is often referred to as 'High Tea'. Although historically this is incorrect. Traditionally, High Tea was a working-class meal rather than for an elite social gathering. It was serviced on a high tea; hence its name 'High Tea' & was served after the working day; around 5 o'clock ish. It was a heavy meal filled with meats, fish, vegetables, baked treats and other heavy foods such as Baked Beans or cheesy Casseroles.
